The Port of Tyne welcomes river use for recreational activity

Don't forget that the River Tyne is a very busy commercial waterway. So it is important that all river users understand, respect and have consideration for each other. Please follow this simple code of behaviour at all times:











Keep to starboard (right hand) side of the channel



Proceed at a safe speed with due regard to the conditions and traffic



Wear a suitable life jacket or buoyancy aid Respect other users' right to lawful navigation

DO NOT



Navigate in an inconsiderate or dangerous way such as;



Inappropriate speed



Creating wash that upsets other river craft



Any behaviour that could cause injury or damage



Swim, dive or engage in underwater activities
