

Covid-19 Occupational Health Policy

1. Introduction

The Port of Tyne Authority is committed to providing a safe working environment for all employees, contractors and visitors during the Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Policy Statement

In order to minimise the risk of occupational exposure and to achieve a covid-secure working environment the Port undertakes to:

- Produce formal risk assessments and ensure these are readily available to all employees
- Implement cleaning, handwashing and hygiene procedures in line with guidance
- Take all reasonable steps to help employees work from home where this is possible
- Take all practical measures to manage transmission risk.
- Proactively communicate and promote 2-way dialogue with employees, safety representatives and trade union safety representatives
- Monitor government guidance, assess the impact of changes in guidance and modify control measures as required
- Implement a compliance enforcement process.

3. Review

The Head of HSEQ is responsible for reviewing this policy.

This policy will be reviewed at least every 6 months to ensure that it is effective, or following any changes to applicable legislation. The Policy will be reissued when revisions are made.
